

# SENATE . . . . No. 479

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To accompany the petition of Gladys L. Garofano for legislation to establish the salaries of the members of the Board of Registration of Hairdressers. Public Service.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

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### AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF HAIRDRESSERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 44 of chapter 13 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended by chapter 561 of the acts of 1951, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out, in line 4, the word  
4 "thirty-five" and inserting in place thereof the word:  
5 — forty-five, — and by striking out, in line 6, the  
6 word "three" and inserting in place thereof the  
7 word: — four, — so as to read as follows: — *Sec-*  
8 *tion 44.* The members of the board shall devote their  
9 full time to the duties of the offices and they shall re-  
10 ceive from the commonwealth the following salaries:  
11 — The chairman, forty-five hundred dollars and his  
12 necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of his  
13 official duties, and each of the other two members  
14 four thousand dollars and the necessary expenses so  
15 incurred; provided, that the salaries and expenses of  
16 the members of the board, and the expenses of the  
17 board, shall not be in excess of the receipts for regis-  
18 tration and from other sources received by the state  
19 treasurer from the board.
