AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN STATE LAND TO A POST OF THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of mental health, in
2 the name and on behalf of the commonwealth, is
3 hereby authorized, subject to the approval of the
4 governor and council, to convey, for a nominal con-
5 sideration to the Boston Police Post No. 1018, Vet-
6 erans of Foreign Wars, Inc., all the right, title and
7 interest of the commonwealth in and to a triangular
8 parcel of land at the Boston State hospital bounded
9 as follows:— Southerly by the American Legion high-
10 way; westerly by Morton street; and northerly by
11 Canterbury street.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
