RESOLVE EXTENDING FOR A LIMITED PURPOSE THE LIFE
OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON THE STRUCTURE OF
THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission es-
2 tablished by chapter seventy-five of the resolves of
3 nineteen hundred and forty-nine is hereby revived
4 effective as of January first, nineteen hundred and
5 fifty-four, and continued until March fifteenth, nine-
6 teen hundred and fifty-four, with the same member-
7 ship as of December thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
8 fifty-three, for the limited purpose of completing its
9 study of the structure of the general and labor service
10 salary schedules and of the existing allocation of offices
11 and positions to salary grades in such schedules. The
12 membership of the commission is hereby increased by
13 two members, one from each of the major political
14 parties, to be appointed by the governor.

15 For the purposes of this resolve, said commission
16 may expend the sum of dollars from the
17 General Fund in advance of the general appropriation.
