AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA TO SUBLEASE A PORTION OF CAMP EDWARDS AT FALMOUTH TO "BOYS' TOWN OF MASSACHUSETTS, INC."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph num-
2 bered 4 of a lease (W218-QM1185) dated August
3 fifteenth, nineteen hundred and forty, between the
4 commonwealth of Massachusetts and the United
5 States of America relating to Camp Edwards, the
6 United States of America acting through the secretary
7 of the army is hereby authorized to lease or sublet
8 so much of said Camp Edwards as appears as Block
9 No. 35 on Master Plan, Camp Edwards, Falmouth,
10 Mass., Sheet No. 28, U. S. Engineer Office, Boston,
11 Mass., together with certain buildings situated thereon,
12 consisting of twenty-one acres more or less, with the
13 right of ingress and egress, to "Boys' Town of Mas-
14 sachusetts, Inc.", at a fair rental value, said premises
15 to be used by said "Boys' Town of Massachusetts,
16 Inc." for residence purposes, and for the training, edu-
17 cational and vocational development of boys.
