AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE LAWRENCE MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL AND INFIRMARY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 38 of Part II of chapter 621
2 of the acts of 1911, as amended by section 1 of chap-
3 ter 335 of the acts of 1953, is hereby further amended
4 by striking out, in line 18, the words "Lawrence
5 municipal" and inserting in place thereof the words:
6 — Bessie M. Burke Memorial.

1 SECTION 2. Section 39A of Part II of said chapter
2 621, inserted by section 2 of said chapter 335, is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the words
4 "Lawrence municipal" and inserting in place thereof
5 the words: — Bessie M. Burke Memorial.

1 SECTION 3. Section 39B of Part II of said chap-
2 ter 621, as so inserted, is hereby amended by striking
3 out, in line 8, the word "administrator" and inserting
4 in place thereof the word: — superintendent.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
