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### AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE GENERAL EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN AIRPORT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 8 of chapter 528 of the acts of 1943 is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the word "Logan" in
- 3 line 2 the word: — International, — so as to read as
- 4 follows: — *Section 8.* Said airport shall be known and
- 5 designated as the General Edward Lawrence Logan
- 6 International Airport, and a suitable tablet or marker
- 7 bearing said designation shall be erected at said air-
- 8 port by the department.
