## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY  
RELATIVE TO CANDIDATES FOR PUBLIC OFFICE MAKING  
KNOWN ANY COMMUNIST AFFILIATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission es-  
2 tablished by chapter eighty-nine of the resolves of  
3 nineteen hundred and fifty-three to study and investi-  
4 gate communism and subversive activities and related  
5 matters in the commonwealth is hereby authorized  
6 and directed to consider in the course of its study and  
7 investigation the subject matter of current house  
8 document numbered 1641, relative to candidates for  
9 public office making known any communist affiliation.  
10 Said commission shall report its findings to the general  
11 court at such time or times as it may deem advisable,  
12 but in any event shall file a final report not later than  
13 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
