AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
TO IMPROVE CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, here-
2 inafter called the department, is hereby authorized
3 and directed to resurface, widen, reconstruct and other-
4 wise improve the following streets in the city of Chel-
5 sea in the vicinity of the Soldiers' Home in Massa-
6 chusetts:— Crest avenue, Hillside avenue, Summit
7 avenue, Clark avenue from Webster avenue to Crest
8 avenue, and Eleanor street from Broadway to Hillside
9 avenue.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act the de-
2 partment, in behalf of the city of Chelsea, may take
3 in fee or otherwise, under chapter seventy-nine of the
4 General Laws, or may acquire by purchase, gift or
5 otherwise, such public or private lands as may be
6 necessary, and any person whose property is taken or
7 damaged by reason thereof may recover for such tak-
8 ing or damage from the city of Chelsea under said
9 chapter seventy-nine.

1 SECTION 3. Upon completion of the work author-
2 ized hereunder, said streets shall be maintained and
3 kept in good repair and condition by the city of
4 Chelsea.

1 SECTION 4. For the purposes of this act, the de-
2 partment may expend such sum, not to exceed one
3 hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars, as may be
4 appropriated therefor from the veterans' services fund.
