AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MYSTIC RIVER BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO COVER ITS EMPLOYEES UNDER THE MASSACHUSETTS EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Mystic River Bridge Authority is hereby au-
2 thorized to insure its employees under the provisions
3 of the employment security law and to become liable
4 for payments instead of contributions as provided in
5 subsection (o) of section fourteen of chapter one hun-
6 dred and fifty-one A of the General Laws.
