

SENATE No. 766

To accompany the petition of Hastings Keith for legislation authorizing the Department of Education to convey a certain parcel of land located in the town of Bridgewater. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of education, in the
2 name and on behalf of the commonwealth, and sub-
3 ject to the approval of the governor and council, may
4 convey to the Bridgewater Ice and Coal Company,
5 for such sum as may be determined by said depart-
6 ment, a parcel of land located on the southerly side
7 of Plymouth street in the town of Bridgewater, which
8 parcel was purchased in the year nineteen hundred
9 and three for educational purposes and does not meet
10 present departmental requirements, said parcel being
11 bounded and described as follows:—

12 Beginning at a stake in said Plymouth street, at a
13 corner of land of the Old Colony Railroad Company;
14 thence by said street north $74^{\circ} 53'$ east, sixty-five feet
15 to a corner of land conveyed by said corporation to
16 Charles Burrill; thence in line of said Burrill land
17 south $23^{\circ} 23'$ east, two hundred sixty-feet to a corner;
18 thence, still by said Burrill land, south $74^{\circ} 35'$ west,

19 sixty-five feet to land of said railroad; thence, in line
20 of said railroad land, north 23° 23' west, two hundred
21 sixty feet to the point of beginning.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
