## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE BORROWING OF FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF AN INLET INTO EEL POND IN THE TOWN OF MATTAPOISETT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of the construction by  
2 the department of public works of a channel or inlet  
3 into Eel pond in the town of Mattapoissett, said town  
4 may borrow outside its limit of indebtedness such  
5 sum, not exceeding in the aggregate, forty-four thou-  
6 sand dollars, as may be necessary, and may issue  
7 bonds or notes therefor, which shall be payable in  
8 not more than ten years, and such indebtedness shall,  
9 except as herein provided, be subject to chapter forty-  
10 four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation  
11 contained in the first paragraph of section seven.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
