AN ACT SETTING ASIDE UNREFUNDED TAXES ON AVIATION GASOLINE FOR AID TO CITY AND TOWN AIRPORTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 39G the following section:—
3 *Section 39H.* A record shall be kept of all moneys
4 received by the commonwealth from excise taxes on
5 aviation gasoline. After the expiration of the time al-
6 lowed for the filing of an affidavit for reimbursement of
7 such excise under section seven of chapter sixty-four A,
8 the unrefunded balance of the amount of such excise
9 taxes shall be credited semiannually on the books of the
10 commonwealth to a fund to be known as the county
11 and municipal airport aid fund. All unexpended bal-
12 ances remaining in said fund at the end of each fiscal
13 year shall be appropriated to the commission for the
14 purposes set forth in sections thirty-nine A and thirty-
15 nine F.
