AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN FILING FEES OF CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 55 of chapter 156 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 314 of the acts of
3 1952, is hereby further amended by inserting the word
4 "amendments" after the sixth word in the first sentence
5 and the word "amendment" after the twenty-first word
6 in the said first sentence, — so as to read as follows: —
7 *Section 55.* The fees for filing all other amendments,
8 certificates, statements or reports required by law of cor-
9 porations shall be fifteen dollars for each amendment,
10 certificate, statement or report, but no fee shall be paid
11 for filing the certificate of change of officers or of annual
12 meeting required by section twenty-four or twenty-nine
13 or the annual tax return required by sections thirty-five
14 and forty of chapter sixty-three.
