AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF AN OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL AND DRESSING ROOMS IN BLUNT PARK IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state department of public works is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to construct an outdoor swimming
3 pool and dressing rooms in Blunt park in the city of
4 Springfield. Upon the completion of said pool and
5 dressing rooms, they shall be turned over to the city of
6 Springfield. The city of Springfield shall thereafter at
7 its own expense maintain said pool and dressing rooms,
8 and may make rules and regulations and fix fees and
9 charges for the use of the same; and all rights, duties
10 and obligations of the said department shall cease. For
11 the purpose of such construction said department may
12 expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
