By Mr. Dolan of Ipswich, petition of John F. Dolan that the Department of Public Works be authorized to designate a traffic circle on Route 128 in Gloucester as the Chester A. Grant memorial circle. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE IN GLOUCESTER ON ROUTE 128 AS THE CHESTER A. GRANT MEMORIAL CIRCLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any other special
2 law or general law, the traffic circle in the city of Gloucester,
3 located on Route 128, shall be designated the
4 Chester A. Grant Memorial Circle. The Department
5 of public works is hereby authorized to designate said
6 traffic circle by the placing of a suitable marker or
7 tablet commemorating the services of the former Chester
8 A. Grant of Gloucester, former city councillor, former
9 executive-secretary of the state retirement board, veteran,
10 and local outstanding citizen of the city of Gloucester;
11 and said department of public works may expend a
12 sum not to exceed one thousand dollars for the erection
13 of such a marker or tablet.
