By Messrs. Tuckerman of Beverly and Murray of Beverly, petition of Hollis A. Bell and others that the Department of Public Works be authorized to designate a bridge in the town of Manchester as the Richard E. Bailey memorial bridge. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT DESIGNATING A BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER AS THE RICHARD E. BAILEY MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The bridge constructed over Pine street
2 on Route 128 in the town of Manchester shall be known
3 and designated as the "Richard E. Bailey Memorial
4 Bridge", and a suitable tablet and marker bearing
5 said designation shall be attached to said bridge and
6 thereafter maintained thereon by the state department
7 of public works.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pasage.
