RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT, OF INSURANCE RATES, COVERAGES AND TYPES OF INSURANCE POLICIES ISSUED ON PROPERTIES IN THIS COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-
2 sist of two members of the senate to be designated by
3 the president thereof, three members of the house of
4 representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof,
5 and two members to be appointed by the governor, is
6 hereby established for the purpose of making an investi-
7 gation and study relative to insurance rates, coverages
8 and types of insurance policies issued on properties in
9 this commonwealth. Said commission shall be provided
10 with quarters in the state house or elsewhere and may
11 expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
12 Said commission shall report to the general court the
13 results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
14 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
15 necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by
16 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representa-
17 tives on or before the first day of June in the current
18 year.
