AN ACT PERMITTING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO USE CERTAIN FUNDS FOR SCHOOL AND ROAD REHABILITATION PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of any general or
2 special law, the city of Springfield is hereby authorized
3 to expend the revenue from parking meters in excess of
4 fifty thousand dollars remaining after the expenditure
5 of all expenses enumerated in General Laws, Tercentenary
6 Edition, chapter forty, section twenty-two A for the
7 reconstruction and resurfacing of highways and for the
8 construction of additions to and the rehabilitation of
9 existing school buildings.
