AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSED BOARDING HOMES FOR THE AGED AND PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR CERTAIN EXPENSES INCURRED THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law, rule or regu-
2 lation to the contrary, licensed boarding homes for the
3 aged may provide care for acutely ill persons and
4 render minor medical care for such patients who do not
5 require nursing home care. Any expenses incurred by
6 cities and towns therefor shall be reimbursed by the
7 commonwealth, in accordance with chapter one hun-
8 dred and seventeen of the General Laws, on the basis
9 of twenty-five dollars per week.
