AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE MEDICAL SERVICE CORPORATIONS
TO CONTRACT WITH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES FOR PRO-
VIDING MEDICAL SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 Section 3 of chapter 176 B of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the fol-
3 lowing paragraph:—

4 Any medical service corporation may contract with
5 any agency of the United States of America, of the com-
6 monwealth or of any city or town within the common-
7 wealth for the purpose of providing medical service.

2. Any medical service corporation may contract with any agency of the United States or any State, or any territory or of any city or town within the Commonwealth for the purpose of providing medical service.
