AN ACT INVALIDATING THE IMPOSING OF DISCRIMINATORY  
COMPULSORY LIABILITY INSURANCE RATES ON OWNERS  
OF MOTOR VEHICLES DRIVEN BY PERSONS UNDER THE AGE  
OF TWENTY-FIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 The action of the commissioner of insurance in the  
2 month of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-three,  
3 in establishing rates for compulsory motor vehicle  
4 liability insurance for motor vehicles owned by, or sub-  
5 ject to being driven by, persons under the age of twenty-  
6 five years is hereby declared invalid, and said discrimi-  
7 natory rates shall not be effective on or after the date  
8 of the enactment of this act.
