By Mr. Palmer of Somerville, petition of Harold A. Palmer that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to construct and maintain a public golf course in the vicinity of Spot Pond in Medford. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A PUBLIC GOLF COURSE IN THE VICINITY OF SPOT POND IN MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct, maintain
3 and operate an eighteen-hole public golf course, includ-
4 ing locker and service buildings and parking accommoda-
5 tions, on land adjoining Spot pond within the Middlesex
6 Fells reservation in the city of Medford. For said pur-
7 poses said commission may expend such sums as may
8 hereafter be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 2. Said commission may establish rules and
2 regulations and make reasonable changes for the use of
3 said golf course, locker and service buildings and parking
4 accommodations.
