AN ACT REDUCING THE PERMISSIVE RETIREMENT AGE TO SIXTY YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section five of
2 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as amended,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out in line nine
4 the words "sixty-five" and substituting in place thereof
5 the word:— sixty.
