AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF LEGAL ASSISTANCE BY THE POLICE COMMISSIONER FOR THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 291 of the acts of
2 1906, as amended by chapter 13, of the acts of 1920, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the words
4 "seven thousand", in the fourth line, and substituting
5 the words: — ten thousand, — so as to read as follows:
6 — *Section 9.* Said police commissioner may employ
7 such legal assistance as he may deem necessary in the
8 performance of his duties, and may incur expense there-
9 for to an amount not exceeding ten thousand dollars in
10 any municipal year, which expense shall be paid by the
11 city of Boston upon the requisition of said police com-
12 missioner.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
