RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO REPEAL THE MCCARRAN-WALTER ACT, SO CALLED, AND THE ELIMINATION OF THE NATIONAL ORIGINS QUOTA SYSTEM.

Resolved, That the general court of Massachusetts hereby urges the Congress of the United States to repeal the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952, commonly known as the McCarran-Walter law; and be it further

Resolved, That the general court of Massachusetts hereby urges the Congress of the United States to pass an Immigration Act which would eliminate the national origins quota system; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be forwarded forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to the presiding officers of both branches of Congress and to the members thereof representing this commonwealth.
