### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF NEWTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 78 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 553 of the acts of  
3 1953, is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
4 first sentence the following sentence:— The salary of  
5 the justice of the district court of Newton shall be nine  
6 thousand dollars., — and by striking out, in lines 15 and  
7 16 of said section 78, as appearing in section 3 of chapter  
8 768 of the acts of 1951, the words “district court of  
9 Newton.”
