Spinney and others (with the approval of the selectmen) that the town of Swampscott be authorized to pay an annuity to the widow of Martin Mastromarino, a former employee of the highway department of said town. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SWAMPSCOTT TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO THE WIDOW OF MARTIN MASTROMARINO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public
2 good, and in consideration of the long and efficient serv-
3 ice of Martin Mastrimarino, former employee of the
4 highway department of the town of Swampscott, said
5 town may appropriate and pay to Rosina Mastromarino,
6 widow of said Martin Mastromarino, so long as she shall
7 remain unmarried, a payment not to exceed twelve hun-
8 dred dollars annually, the same to be paid in equal
9 monthly installments.

1 SECTION 2. This action will take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
