AN ACT INCREASING THE DEDUCTIONS FOR DEPENDENTS  
ALLOWED FOR INCOME TAX PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (*h*) of section 6 of chapter 62  
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 657 of  
3 the acts of 1954, is hereby amended by striking out, in  
4 line 1, the words "five hundred" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the words:— seven hundred and fifty.

1 SECTION 2. Said subsection (*h*) is hereby further  
2 amended by striking out, in line 6, the words "four  
3 hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words:—  
4 six hundred and fifty.
