AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHANGE OF PARTY ENROLLMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 38 of chapter 53 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence of said section
3 and substituting in place thereof the following:—

4 *Section 38.* No voter enrolled under this or the pre-
5 ceding section shall be allowed to receive the ballot of
6 any political party except that with which he is so en-
7 rolled; but a voter may, except within a period begin-
8 ning with the thirty-first day prior to a primary and
9 ending with the day prior thereto, establish, change or
10 cancel his enrollment by appearing in person before a
11 member of the board of registrars of voters, an election
12 commissioner, a notary public, or a justice of the peace,
13 and requesting in writing to have his enrollment estab-
14 lished with a party, changed to another party, or can-
15 celled, and such enrollment, change or cancellation shall
16 take effect at the expiration of thirty days after said re-
17 quest has been filed with the board of registrars of voters
18 or election commission.
