AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN LAWS AFFECTING VETERANS AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE POLISH AMERICAN VETERANS OF MASSACHUSETTS, INC., AND ITS AFFILIATED POSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause (12) of section 5 of chapter 40 of
2 the General Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended
3 by inserting after the word “(Incorporated)” in line 40,
4 as appearing in section 2 of chapter 27 of the acts of
5 1950, the words: — , Polish American Veterans of Mas-
6 sachusetts, Inc., and its affiliated posts.

1 SECTION 2. Section 70 of chapter 266 of the General
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by insert-
3 ing after the word “League” in line 20, as appearing
4 in section 3 of chapter 27 of the acts of 1950, the words:
5 — , Polish American Veterans of Massachusetts, Inc.,
6 and its affiliated posts.
