AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS IN THE PERMANENT SALARY SCHEDULES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (2) of section 46 of chapter 30 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 407 of
3 the acts of 1954, is hereby amended by inserting before
4 the last sentence the following sentence:— No person
5 shall be required to perform services for more than
6 twelve years in the aggregate in order to receive the
7 maximum increment provided under the general salary
8 schedule, notwithstanding that he has been promoted to
9 a higher salary grade either before or after having served
10 the maximum of twelve years provided therein.
