AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE WORDS "LEGAL HOLIDAYS".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 135 of the acts of
2 1948 is hereby amended by adding at the end the fol-
3 lowing sentence: — The provisions of this act shall apply
4 to those men whose hours of duty are within the twenty-
5 four hour period commencing at seven forty-five ante-
6 meridian on the days there specified.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
