AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES ON WAYS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 463 of the acts of 1953, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the last para-
4 graph, as inserted by chapter 282 of the acts of 1941,
5 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
6 A corporation organized under the laws of this com-
7 monwealth, or a person resident therein, having a
8 place of business in another state or a foreign country
9 shall, with respect to the operation upon the ways of
10 this commonwealth of a motor vehicle, trailer or semi-
11 trailer which is used in connection with such place of
12 business, is customarily garaged in such other state or
13 foreign country and is registered therein, have the rights
14 and privileges and be subject to the obligations im-
15 posed by this section.
