*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appear-  
2 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out, in line 10, the word "eighty" and inserting  
4 in place thereof the word: — seventy.
