AN ACT RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGES FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 40 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 69 of the acts of 1952,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the first sen-
4 tence and inserting in place thereof the following sen-
5 tence:— The compensation of every teacher employed
6 in any public day school in the commonwealth, except
7 persons in training and those employed as temporary
8 substitutes, shall be at a rate of not less than three thou-
9 sand dollars for the school year in that school.
