AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE ASSISTANT CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN HAMPDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 80 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the
3 period at the end thereof and adding the following
4 words:—, except that in the district court of western
5 Hampden the salary of the assistant clerk shall be three
6 thousand dollars.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE REGISTER GENERAL OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Conference on the 21st day of February, A. D. 1918.

1. Section 80 of chapter 212 of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "and the amount and nature of the salary" and inserting in their place the words "except that in the district where he resides the salary of the register shall be not more than four thousand dollars."
