AN ACT TO PROTECT THE STABILITY OF OBLIGATIONS ISSUED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF SECTION 26NN OF CHAPTER 121 OF THE GENERAL LAWS, AS AMENDED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 26NN of chapter 121
2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
3 chapter 667 of the acts of 1954 is hereby amended by
4 adding the following provision to the last sentence thereof
5 after the word "units":— then to other persons of low
6 income living in substandard housing; provided, that
7 no eligible veterans apply for such units; and provided,
8 further, that those parts of projects suitable for occu-
9 pancy by elderly persons may be made available to other
10 persons of low income living in substandard housing
11 only to the extent that no eligible veterans or elderly
12 persons of low income apply for such units.
