## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO THE WIDOW OF MICHAEL F. O'REILLY, A FORMER MEMBER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester, for the purpose of  
2 promoting public good, is hereby authorized to appro-  
3 priate and to pay to Josephine M. O'Reilly, widow of  
4 Michael F. O'Reilly, who died on November sixth, nine-  
5 teen hundred and twenty-seven, from injuries received  
6 in the performance of duty as a member of the police  
7 department of said city, an annuity, for life, of the sum  
8 of one thousand dollars, the same to be paid in equal  
9 monthly installments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city, sub-  
3 ject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
