The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN REGISTERED ASSISTANT PHARMACISTS AS PHARMACISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section twenty-four
2 of chapter one hundred and twelve of the General Laws,
3 a person who has held a certificate of registration as an
4 assistant pharmacist for at least four years and has had
5 four years of actual experience as such assistant phar-
6 macist, and who has been employed in a drug store within
7 one year of the filing of an application for registration as
8 a pharmacist hereunder, shall, upon application to the
9 board of registration in pharmacy and upon the payment
10 of ten dollars to said board, be entitled to an examination
11 for registration as a pharmacist. Upon passing such
12 examination, such person shall be registered as a phar-
13 macist, and shall receive a certificate of registration
14 signed by the president and secretary of said board.
