By Mr. Keenan of Boston, petition of William Francis Keenan for increasing the salaries of officers and employees in the service of the Commonwealth. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES IN THE SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of each person in the service
2 of the commonwealth and paid from the treasury
3 thereof is hereby increased by the amount of three
4 hundred and sixty dollars. The salary increase
5 granted hereunder in the case of any person whose
6 basic salary is changed by promotion, step-rate in-
7 crease, transfer or otherwise, shall be based on his
8 basic salary as so changed.

1 SECTION 2. The general salary schedule as appear-
2 ing in section forty-six of chapter thirty of the General
3 Laws, as amended by section one of chapter seven
4 hundred and fifteen of the acts of nineteen hundred
5 and fifty-one, is hereby further amended by increasing
6 the rates for each salary grade by three hundred and
7 sixty dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of July
2 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
