By Mr. O'Sullivan of Boston, petition of John B. Hynes (mayor) that provision be made for facilitating the conveyance to the city of Boston of real estate owned by the Commonwealth in said city. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT TO FACILITATE THE CONVEYANCE TO THE CITY OF BOSTON OF REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whenever a state department, commission, board or
2 officer having control of any real estate of the common-
3 wealth shall, with the approval of the governor and
4 council, determine that any such real estate in the city
5 of Boston is no longer needed for the purposes of the
6 commonwealth, such department, commission, board or
7 officer may, in the name and behalf of the common-
8 wealth, sell and convey to the city of Boston such real
9 estate, or any part or parts thereof, or any interest
10 therein, for such price as such department, commission,
11 board or officer, with the approval of the governor and
12 council, shall determine. This act shall apply whether
13 the real estate was acquired by the commonwealth before
14 or after the effective date of this act, and whether by
15 eminent domain, purchase, gift, devise or otherwise.
