### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE EXCISE UPON CHARGES FOR MEALS SERVED TO THE PUBLIC.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 64B of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out "including cover and other
- 3 charges" so as to read as follows:—
- 4 "Taxable charge", any amount charged for meals
- 5 whenever furnished within the commonwealth, for which
- 6 the purchaser is charged as a total one dollar or more,
- 7 except meals exempt under section two A.
