AN ACT TO RATIFY AND CONFIRM THAT PORTION OF A VOTE OF THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH RELATIVE TO THE ASSESSMENTS ON OWNERS OF LAND SERVED BY THE WOODS HOLE SEWERAGE SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That portion of the vote passed under
2 article 20 of the town of Falmouth special town meeting
3 held on December fifth, nineteen hundred and fifty,
4 which specifies that a portion of the cost of the Woods
5 Hole sewerage system to be paid by the owners of the
6 territory served shall be assessed on the basis of two
7 dollars and fifty cents per foot on the frontage of such
8 land on any way in which said sewer is constructed,
9 provided, that if land abuts upon more than one way,
10 such assessment shall apply on one such way, and the
11 other way shall be subject to an exemption of not less
12 than sixty feet, and also provides that there shall be an
13 annual rental or use charge of fifty per cent of the annual
14 water bill, is hereby ratified and confirmed as in full
15 legal force and effect notwithstanding the provisions of
16 General Laws, chapter eighty-three, section twenty-
17 three, and of the other and conflicting portions of said
18 vote.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
