RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF FREDERICK CASSIDY OF BROCKTON.

1 *Resolved*, That notwithstanding the provisions of any
2 general or special law to the contrary, Frederick Cassidy
3 of Brockton, a former employee of the department of pub-
4 lic works, shall be entitled to receive from the common-
5 wealth the sum of twenty dollars per week for the re-
6 mainder of his life, and payments shall be retroactive to
7 the date he was separated from his employment. The
8 expenses for this purpose shall be appropriated from the
9 same source from which said employee received his
10 salary.
