## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

### AN ACT ESTABLISHING NEW WARD LINES FOR THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In December of nineteen hundred and  
2 fifty-five, the city of Boston, by vote of its city council,  
3 shall make a new division of its territory into not more  
4 than twenty wards. The boundaries of such wards shall  
5 be so arranged that the wards shall contain, as nearly as  
6 can be ascertained and as may be consistent with well-  
7 defined limits to each ward, an equal number of voters.  
8 The city clerk shall forthwith give written notice to the  
9 state secretary of the number and designations of the  
10 wards so established, together with an official copy of  
11 the description of said wards.

1 SECTION 2. This new division into not more than  
2 twenty wards shall become effective in the year nineteen  
3 hundred and fifty-eight at the state election at which  
4 representatives are to be elected from new representative  
5 districts established under the provisions of the con-  
6 stitution of the commonwealth.
