## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

### AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF ACTON UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The positions of David Scribner and  
2 Warren Birch, members of the police department of  
3 the town of Acton, shall, upon the effective date of this  
4 act, become subject to the civil service laws and rules  
5 relating to police officers in towns, and their tenure of  
6 office shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said laws;  
7 provided, that they pass a qualifying examination to  
8 which they shall be subjected by the division of civil  
9 service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
