AN ACT PLACING THE INCUMBENT OF THE POSITION OF LABOR MANAGEMENT AGENT OF THE PORT OF BOSTON COMMISSION UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The incumbent of the position of labor management
2 agent of the Port of Boston Commission on the effec-
3 tive date of this act shall, upon passing a qualifying ex-
4 amination to which he shall be subjected by the division
5 of civil service, continue to serve in said position subject
6 to the civil service laws and rules, and his tenure of office
7 shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said laws and
8 rules. Upon passing said examination, he shall be
9 deemed to be permanently appointed to said position
10 without being required to serve any probationary period.
