AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OBSERVANCE OF VETERANS DAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first sentence of clause 18 of section 7 of chapter  
2 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 190 of  
3 the acts of 1946, is hereby amended by striking out, in  
4 line 11, the words "and November eleventh", — by  
5 striking out, in line 14, the words "or November  
6 eleventh", — and by further striking out, in lines 17 to  
7 20, inclusive, the words "and except that on November  
8 eleventh, or on the day following when November  
9 eleventh occurs on Sunday, hunting during said hours,  
10 if otherwise lawful, shall not be prohibited."
