AN ACT PROVIDING FOR IMPROVING AND STRAIGHTENING THE
COURSE OF THE MYSTIC RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to straighten the flow of
3 the Mystic river from the Wellington bridge and to con-
4 struct a bay area, with a boat house, bathhouses, play
5 areas and such other structures and facilities as may be
6 necessary to provide suitable and adequate recreation
7 and to maintain the same. For such purposes, said com-
8 mission shall appropriate the sum of five million dollars
9 therefor.

1 SECTION 2. On or before the first Wednesday of
2 December, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, and each
3 succeeding year the said commission shall report to the
4 clerk of the house of representatives what progress has
5 been made in ridding the said Mystic river of pollution.
