
By Mr. Rawson of Newton, petition of George E. Rawson that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to convey a parcel of land located in Cambridge, Arlington and Belmont. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONVEY ANY PART OR ALL OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED IN CAMBRIDGE, ARLINGTON AND BELMONT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chap-
2 ter four hundred and ninety-one of the acts of nineteen
3 hundred and fifty-one the metropolitan district com-
4 mission is hereby authorized to sell and convey in the
5 name and behalf of the commonwealth, to such person or
6 persons as it may determine, at one time or from time to
7 time, such part or all of the land and appurtenances
8 owned by the commonwealth and under control of said
9 commission, and described in said chapter four hundred
10 and ninety-one, as is not required for the purposes of the
11 Metropolitan Transit Authority, at such price and upon
12 such terms as the commission may deem adequate and
13 fair.

1 SECTION 2. This sale and conveyance shall be subject
2 to such easements for drainage or otherwise as shall be
3 determined by the metropolitan district commission.

1 SECTION 3. Said commission may, at one time or
2 from time to time, in the name and behalf of the com-

3 monwealth, execute and deliver a good and sufficient
4 deed or deeds to convey part or all of the said land and
5 appurtenances under the provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 4. The moneys received by the commission
2 shall be deposited with the department of the treasurer
3 and receiver general. The treasurer shall prorate and
4 credit the total in the year that the moneys are received,
5 to abate the assessments for metropolitan parks and
6 boulevards, as follows:— Forty-seven per cent thereof
7 to the city of Cambridge, twelve per cent thereof to the
8 city of Somerville, twenty-four per cent thereof to the
9 town of Arlington, and seventeen per cent thereof to the
10 town of Belmont.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
